

Removal of Stock System:

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Remove the hardware from the stock extension pipes. Keep for reinstallation. **Refer to Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the exhaust from the rubber insulators. **Refer to Figure 2**.
- 4. Remove the exhaust from the rearmost hanger. Leave the rubber insulators on the truck for installation. **Refer to Figure 3**.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

- 1. Install the **Driver Side Extension Pipe** reusing the existing hardware and attaching the hanger to the existing rubber insulator. Hand-tighten the hardware leaving it loose enough for adjustment. **Refer to Figure 4**.
- 2. Install the **Passenger Side Extension Pipe** reusing the existing hardware. Hand-tighten the hardware leaving it loose enough for adjustment.

- 3. Slide the **2.5"** Band Clamps over the Passenger Side Extension Pipe and Driver Side Extension Pipe. Install the Muffler onto the two front pipes. Refer to Figure 6.
- 4. Slide a **3" Band Clamp** over the outlet side of the **Muffler**. Position the **Over Axle Pipe** and loosely attach it to the **Muffler**. Install the hanger into the existing rubber insulator. **Refer to Figure 7**.
- 5. Slide a **3" Band Clamp** over the **Tail Pipe** and install it onto the **Over Axle Pipe**. Slide the **Tail Pipe** hanger into the rearmost rubber insulator. **Refer to Figure 8**.
- 7. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tip** to suit. Using a 17mm wrench tighten the lock bolt located on the **Exhaust Tip**. **Refer to Figure 8**.
- 8. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.
- 9. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire and fuel and brake lines. Realign if necessary.
